Genotropin MiniQuick Instructions for use

Peel paper covering from needle. Attach needle to Genotropin® MiniQuick by pushing and turning until it stops.

Please make sure the needle is positioned **squarely** onto the end of the rubber bung before screwing it to the Genotropin® MiniQuick.

Please note

If any resistance is felt during Stage 2 and 3 it could be the needle has not been positioned correctly on top of the Genotropin® MiniQuick. This will result in the needle being inserted at an angle inside the rubber stopper and a high pressure will have built up inside the cartridge as the air cannot escape.

To rectify this, carefully replace the outer needle cap (opaque white one) over the needle and twist anti-clockwise to remove the needle.

Holding the Genotropin® MiniQuick syringe vertically (needle end upwards) reposition the needle squarely on top of the syringe (if the needle is not pointing upwards, the release of pressure inside the cartridge could result in the solution being expelled instead of the air).

If necessary, apply a new needle to the Genotropin® MiniQuick.
